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**Dieline Details**

**Yellow = Cut Tolerance**

Please allow for the cut tolerance. Always make sure your artwork matches along both yellow edges.

**Purple Dash = Safe Areas**

Don't accidentally trim off important information or fold it onto another panel. Keep all important text and design elements inside the purple safe areas.

**Blue = Optional Features**

Go ahead! Add a zipper. Add a hang hole. Remove the tear notch. Simply select these options when ordering and they will be placed where marked in blue.
